Anadolu University - Brief History

1958

- Founded as Eskişehir Academy of Economic and Commercial Sciences
- First Higher Education Institution in Eskişehir City

1982

- Changed its name to Anadolu University
- Among largest universities not only in Türkiye, but also in the world

2006

- European Credit Transfer System(ECTS) was launched at Anadolu University, one of the first universities to do this in Türkiye

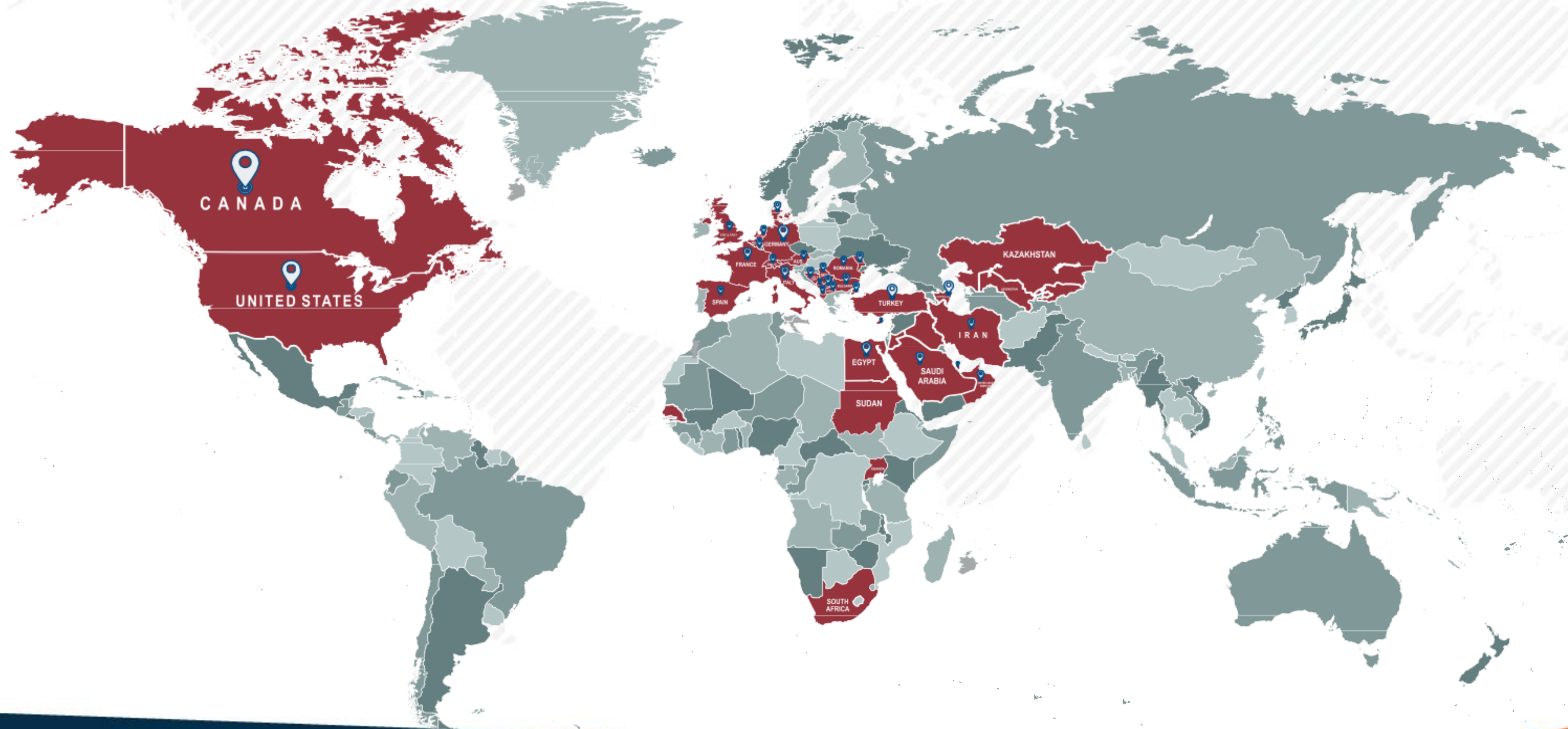

>65 : 2 %



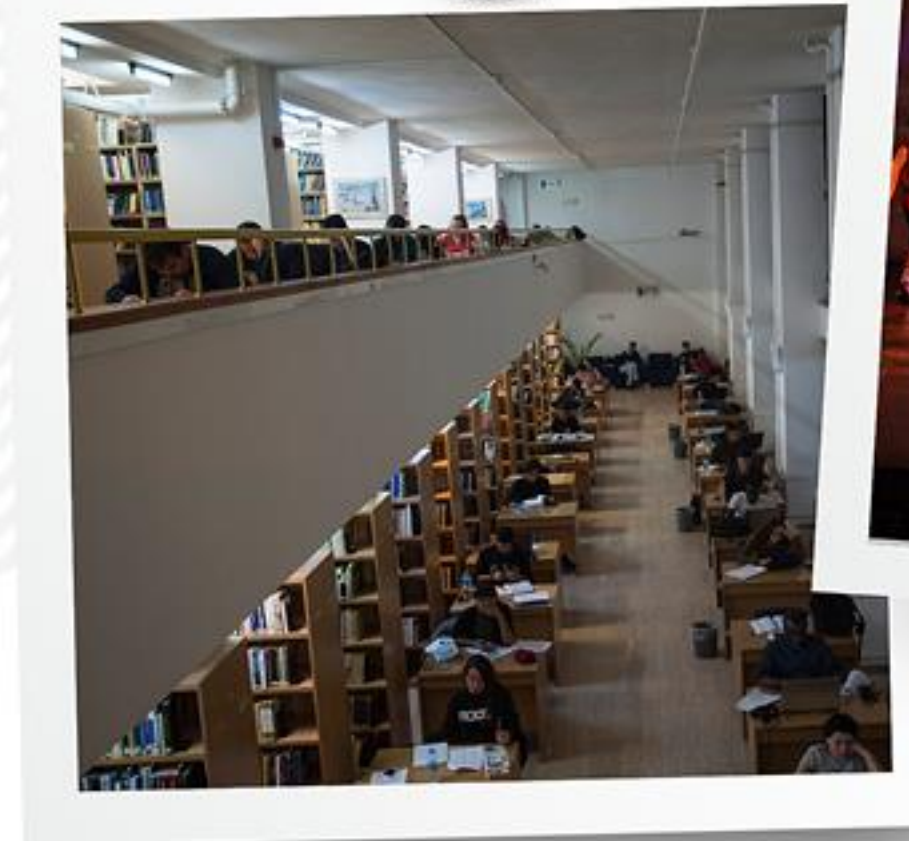
Why Anadolu University?

International Cooperation Protocols (MoU)

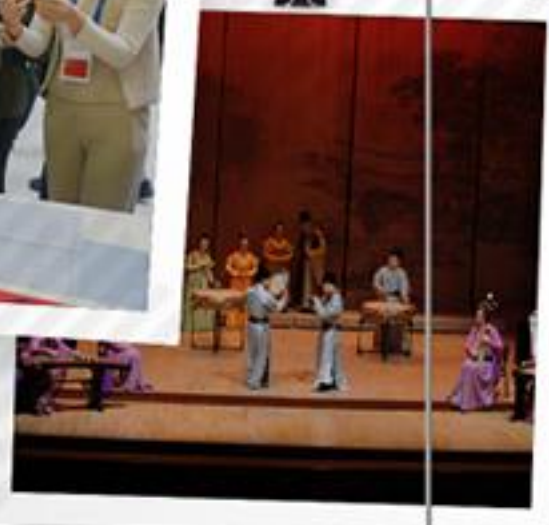
More than **140** international cooperation protocols with institutions from more than **48** different countries, including, but not limited to:
