Useful Information for Incoming Students

Accommodation	<p>All incoming students are assigned to a suitable accommodation, a flat to share with Turkish students according to their preferences stated in "Housing Application Form". Before moving in, they may stay in the University Guest House up to five days for free. Also, students may prefer to stay in an apart hostel, instead of the flat arranged by International Affairs Office.</p>
Visa & Residence Permit	<p>As soon as accepted by Anadolu University, all incoming students have to contact the nearest Turkish Consulate to obtain a student visa. After their arrival, the students are obliged to apply for Resident Permit within one month. Health Insurance	<p>International students must have a health insurance policy providing inpatient and outpatient treatment abroad. If the student has no insurance, s/he will be able to get an insurance policy from The Social Security Institution of Turkey (SGK) or any private health insurance company.</p>
Buddy System	<p>The incoming students are also assigned to buddy students. Buddy students help incoming students with their travel arrangements and registration. In addition, they inform exchange students about the university, city as well as the country.</p>
Dining Options	<p>Exchange students may benefit from the university dining hall service for a fee (daily meal plan for €) as well as an array of dining options on campus.</p>
Services for Students with Special Needs or Disabilities	<p>The campus of Anadolu University is very well designed for students with special needs with its wide variety of services and facilities.
